

# St Martin De Porres Catholic Primary School – Early Years – Understanding the World Learning Journey



## EYFS

22 to 36 months

Imitates everyday actions in pretend play and events from their own family and cultural background.

Enjoys playing with small-world models such as a farm, a garage, or a train track.

Operates mechanical toys, e.g. turns the knob on a wind-up toy or pulls back on a friction car.

30 to 50 months

Recognises and describes special times and events for family and friends.

Knows how to operate simple equipment.



## EYFS

40-60 months

Makes observations of animals and plants and explains why some things occur, and talk about changes.

Shows care and concern for living things and the environment.

Can talk about some of the things they have observed such as plants, animals, natural and found objects

Shows skill in making toys work by pressing parts or lifting flaps to achieve effects such as sound and movements.

Completes a simple program on a computer.



Knows about similarities and differences between them self and others, and among families, communities and traditions.



Knows that the environment and living things are influenced by human activity.

Knows the properties of some materials and can suggest some of the purposes they are used for.

Demonstrates familiarity with basic scientific concepts such as floating and sinking.
