This term pupils in Key Stages One and Two will be studying the three themes of Local Church (Community), Eucharist (Relating) and Lent/Easter (Giving). Each year group will approach the themes through different topics.

Yr 5 Memorial Sacrifice - Eucharist as the living Memorial of Christ's sacrifice Yr 6 Unity - Eucharist enabling people to live in communion Lent/Easter - Giving At home 7th March - End of Term As a family talk about how you are Yr 1 Change - Lent; a time for change going to practice self-control and selfgiving for the rest of the season of Yr 2 Opportunities - Lent; an opportunity to start anew Yr 3 Giving All - Lent; remembering Jesus' total giving Lent. Yr 4 Self Discipline - Celebrating growth to new life If you have an older child, provide Yr 5 Sacrifice - Lent; a time of aligning with the Sacrifice made by Jesus him/her with an opportunity to take Yr 6 Death & New Life - Celebrating Jesus' death and resurrection part in The Stations of the Cross.

As directed by Northampton Diocese, pupils in Nursery and Reception will begin to follow the new Religious Education curriculum. Each topic lasts for half a term.

Lent Term 1

Galilee to Jerusalem	Desert to Garden
This branch of the curriculum explores the life of Jesus and pupils will experience His ministry and teachings through parables, miracles and teachings. Pupils will explore the idea that Jesus welcomes and takes care of everyone. Pupils will think about how we can take care of other people.	This branch of the curriculum focuses on the season of Lent and the events of Holy week. Pupils will explore the idea that Lent is a tine to grow closer to Jesus and to grow in love for others. Pupils will become familiar with the events celebrated in Holy Week.
