

<u>RE</u>

Journeys -Children will learn about the Liturgical calendar, identifying the seasons and what celebrations occur throughout the year.

Listening and sharing - Children will discuss the importance of listening to the Liturgy of the Word so that we can follow the messages in our daily lives.

Giving all - Children will learn that Lent is an opportunity for us to give to others and then focus on the events leading up to Jesus' crucifixion.

<u>English</u>

Texts: The Velveteen Rabbit and Zoo

Grammar focus: use conjunctions, adverbs and prepositions to express time and cause, use commas after fronted adverbials, use possessive apostrophe with plural nouns and use paragraphs to organise ideas.

<u>History / Geography</u>

History - Why did the Romans settle in Britain? Children will learn about the Roman invasion of Britain and explain how the Roman army's structure, discipline and equipment made it so successful.

Geography - Who lives in Antarctica? Children will identify the lines of latitude and longitude, learn about the different climate zones, describe Antarctica's location and find out about the reasons why people would travel there.
