RE

Energy - Children are learning how the Holy Spirit was given to the disciples to witness.

Choices - Children will be learning to examine their conscience in order to make good choices and minimise bad effects for themselves and others.

In the second half of the summer term, we will be introducing the new Religious Education Directory. Our topic will be 'Creation and Covenant'. Within this topic, we will be looking at the first creation story from Genesis and the belief that human beings are made in the image of God.
