#### September return to school

Year 6 and Year 4 should enter via the playground gate from the pavement.

Year 5 and Year 3 should enter via the central gate in the car park.

All children must be accompanied by an adult, as a member of staff will not be responsible for the children prior to them entering the playground.

#### Face coverings

At the time of sending this Newsletter, the government advice around face coverings is that you will no longer need to wear one when coming onto the school site. However, if you are coming into the school building, we will ask you to wear a face covering.

#### School Uniform

From September, we will expect all children to return to school in the correct school uniform (grey trousers/skirts — not black). This includes PE kit (navy or black plain tracksuit, no hoodies or logos). No hooped or hook earrings and all studs to be removed on PE day at home. (Studs should only be plain gold or silver). All hair below the shoulder must be tied back with a small suitable band in royal blue, grey, black or white. Badged items such as sweatshirts can be ordered via the link on our website. Please make sure that all items of clothing are clearly labelled. A book bag is all that is required for the children to bring items to and from school. If you do purchase a rucksack, it needs to be small as there is very little space in the cloakrooms.

Children will continue to wear PE kit into school on PE days, so please make a note of which days these are for your child.

Care Club

Opening Times: 7.50 -8.50 am 3.00 -5.30pm

When we return to school in September 2021, the school will continue to close on Friday afternoons and will not be offering Friday activities. There are on-going procedures that we have to put into place because of COVID19 and minimising different groups of children mixing will be one of them.

I realise that this may cause some difficulties for working parents. I have agreed with the Local Governing Body that the school will offer 50 paid places on a Friday between 1.30 and 4pm at Care Club's standard rate of £4 per hour. (For families with more than one child, there will be a reduction in cost for the second/third child to £2 per hour.)

Parents/carers will need to pre-book as they do for Care Club now — priority will be offered to Key worker and staff children. This facility will only be available to working parents/carers and will require proof that both parents/carers are working on a Friday afternoon. Single parents will also need to provide proof that they are working on a Friday afternoon.

In line with our COVID risk assessment, the children in Care Club will be kept in their year groups to reduce the possibility of transmission of the virus.

All places must be pre-booked and a registration form must have been completed before a child may attend

Care Club on a Friday afternoon will not be available for Nursery pupils and will only be available for Reception pupils who have siblings in Year 1 or above.

Booking for Care Club will open on Monday 23rd August 2021

The Government's scheme for Universal Infant Free School Meals remains in force (for now!) so there will still be no charge for Reception and Years 1&2.

Free School Meals (not to be confused with Universal Infant Free School Meals)
If your circumstances have changed since last completing the form regarding Free School Meals then please complete a new one to see if you are now eligible. Not only will your child receive a school meal and other benefits, such as free school trips, but the school will also receive some extra funding. Forms are available from the school office and we are happy to help parents to complete these.
