Last week we had 3,325 stories shared and 1093 skills shown across the school on Class Dojo, which is amazing. Thank you so much for supporting your children with this work. Remember to let us know if you are still having problems.

We are able to deliver paper based activities to those who are not able to access the internet, so please let us know.

We hope that the children have enjoyed speaking to their teachers over the phone this week. If you have not had a call yet, they will be in contact next week. They are also happy to talk to you about any concerns that you may have and can signpost you to some other professionals for support.

#LutonSchoolRun

Last week, over 30 staff from St Martin's took part in the LutonSchoolRun. Daniel Chaplen who organised the event sent this through:

Thank you everyone for taking part in the #LutonSchoolRun on Friday. The event went beyond any of our exceptions in terms of both involvement and fundraising. This was down to the involvement and commitment from everyone who took part on the day; everyone really went above and beyond.

The current figures have shown that we had 712 people taking part from 39 different schools/organizations.

Collectively we covered a distance of 3,047.1 miles in the 12 hours and raised a whopping £25,433.00 and counting, meaning we have now more than doubled the initial £12.5k target. (Final figure raised is £26,164) Including Gift Aid this event will give Level Trust £30,526.40 to support families and children across the town with food, clothing and resources, now and into the rest of the year.
